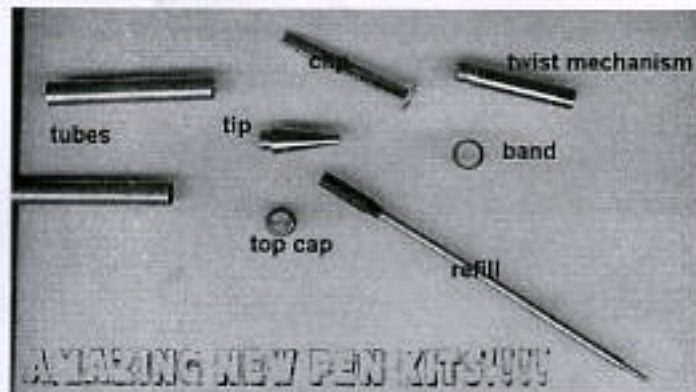


Amazing Twist Pens - by Boston ClayWorks (patent pending)

Instructions

- 1) Take out the two hollow tubes. If you stand the 2 tubes on their ends (on a flat surface) you will notice that one tube is a tiny bit longer than the other. The longer one is the "top", the shorter is the "bottom". Alternatively, if you can't tell which is longer, you can look at the inside of the 2 tubes and you will notice that there are screw threads inside. The "top" only has screw threads in one end - the "bottom" has threads on both ends.
- 2) Cover the two tubes with your clay designs. Trim any excess from the ends, and bake.
- 3) Finish the barrels by sanding, and applying a finish if desired.



Assembly

- 1) Screw the 'top cap' and 'clip' into the threaded end of the top tube. The cap will hold the clip in place.
- 2) Take the bottom tube and screw the tip into one end. Twist the 'twist mechanism' into the other end of the bottom tube. ****NOTE - some of the pen shipments recently have had mechanisms that are VERY tight going into the tube. This issue is being resolved with the vendor, but in the meantime, if you experience difficulty inserting the twist mechanism into the tube, just add a drop or two of oil into the top tube (or on the mechanism) and the problem should be resolved.****
- 3) Slide the 'band' onto the twist mechanism.
- 4) Insert the 'refill' into the opening on top of the 'twist mechanism', and screw tightly into place.
- 5) Push both halves of the remaining assembly together.

To operate: holding the top barrel in place, twist the bottom barrel to expose or retract the refill (or you can hold the bottom barrel and twist the top!).
